

release of its
Annual Tourism
Report. It covers



the outlook for the local tourism sector, one of our most important industries.

Included is a forecast by Moody's, a local progress report from the state Travel and Tourism Commission, and an industry survey conducted by the Economic Development Board (EDB).

Highlights include:

- Moody's predicts that the longterm outlook for tourism is strong here, with the improved local airport and our growing reputation as a premier tourist destination driving expansion.
- TOT tax receipts, industry earnings and the like are at record highs in Sonoma County; and occupancy rates are very strong.
- The EDB Industry survey reveals that local lodging owners are very positive for the upcoming year, and more lodging businesses are expanding their operations
