#### \* Change in Pot of Gold Prize Policy

## RUBBLE FROM SONOMA COUNTY WILDFIRES IS PREPPED FOR ROAD, HOME CONSTRUCTION

Local businesses are still working hard on recycling materials from areas of the North Bay that burned last fall. Spokesperson Kristyn Byrne of Pruitt Industrial Park in Windsor explained.

Large pieces of concrete from foundations are crushed to make <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-inch recycled base rock that meets CalTrans specifications for reuse under sidewalks, roads, and foundations. Metal such as rebar is also separated out during the breaking up process. It too can be completely recycled.

Doing the work locally helps in the rebuilding efforts because it creates a local source for important material. The fires created debris equivalent in weight to two Golden Gate Bridges, which meant significant logistical challenges that had to be overcome.
