MARK WEST COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT UPDATE

The proposed formation of the Mark West Community Services District is proceeding through the formal formation process. Supervisor Paul Kelley has successfully presented the proposal to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors and the item is scheduled to be heard by the Sonoma Local Agency Formation Commission (Sonoma LAFCO) on Wednesday, July 21, 2010, at 2:00 PM.

Members of the Mark West community are encouraged to attend the meeting in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, 575 Administration Drive, Santa Rosa. The seven commissioners will review the proposal and vote on whether or not to continue the process.

As proposed, the district would start with the very narrow focus of taking responsibility for street lighting in the community. The district could also become the most defined point of local government in the area and would also be permitted to comment on local issues and could be an advocate for such things as lower rates for solid waste disposal. In the future, the district could assume more services if the community so desires.
