

FYI: E-Waste Recycling Centers

Since July 2005, **Goodwill Industries of the Redwood Empire (GIRE)** has provided free electronic waste recycling services to the citizens of Sonoma County. GIRE, a California Integrated Waste Management Board approved electronic waste collector, provides this service though community collection drives and at our seven (7) Sonoma County Retail Stores and four (4) Attended Donation Centers.

In our two years of operation, we have collected and recycled over 600,000 pounds of electronic waste. The collection and de-manufacturing of electronics provides employment and training opportunities for people with disabilities and other special needs. In addition, the revenues generated from this effort support GIRE's other Sonoma County community programs providing job training and placement services that foster self-sufficiency. When we initially began this program, we were the only service provider in the area that did not charge the donor a fee for this service. Additionally, being a 501(c)(3) organization, GIRE provides donation receipts that allow donors to potentially receive a tax benefit for the value of their donation.

We have recently learned that an East Bay Corporation is approaching government entities and Chambers of Commerce to promote e-Waste drives in exchange for a small share of the revenues generated from the collection of CRTs (currently \$.025 per pound). We encourage you to consider GIRE as your e-Waste partner instead.

GIRE is prepared to staff and handle the logistics of an e-Waste drive in your community and compete with the for-profit organization's offer to share revenues generated by the recycling of CRTs. The employees participating in these e-Waste drives are from our local communities and any proceeds stay in Sonoma County to support our programs and services. By also offering these services at our store and donation center locations, we provide your constituents with the service all year, and not only times of organized drives.

I would encourage you to ask your appointed representative to the Sonoma County Integrated Waste Management Agency to consider Goodwill as an e-Waste recycling partner. As with community donation drives, using Goodwill will provide employment opportunities to local residents, and keep the revenues generated by this program in Sonoma County to support Welfare to Work and other job training programs.

GIRE currently is the exclusive e-Waste recycler for the County of Sonoma, and provides e-Waste recycling services to the City of Santa Rosa, Santa Rosa Junior College and Friedman Bros., among others.




